

## Matthew 12:9-13 NASB

<sup>9</sup>Departing from there, He went into their synagogue. <sup>10</sup>And a man was *there* whose hand was withered. And they questioned Jesus, asking, “Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?”—so that they might accuse Him. <sup>11</sup>And He said to them, “What man is there among you who has a sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will he not take hold of it and lift it out? <sup>12</sup>How much more valuable then is a man than a sheep! So then, it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath.” <sup>13</sup>Then He said to the man, “Stretch out your hand!” He stretched it out, and it was restored to normal, like the other.
