The FBCSA family is united by a unique design for Bible study. We call it Re:Verse. The name implies doing something, then backing up and doing it again. Re:Verse is an encounter with a designated scripture 5 different ways in a week's time.

READ DAILY: alone with the Re:Verse scripture for reflection and prayer

PASTOR'S BLOG: (TheEverydayPrayer.com): reading a daily contemplation prompted by the scriptures

BIBLE STUDY: meeting in groups around the scriptures for discussion and mutual support

WORSHIP: assembling with the larger church to hear the scripture preached and sung.

CIRCLES OF SIX: gathering with a small group of friends around the scriptures with a focus on application and obedient action.
