

Greetings Church Family...Because of God's provision we have been able to find a source to feed all of the families every week! This is why we are changing the list of needed items. Starting next week we will have food boxes already packed and ready for delivery. We will post a Needs List that asks for deliverers, curbside runners, bagging of remaining material donations, prepping bulk meat, eggs, and toilet paper. This is all possible because you give generously, you pray fervently, and you care deeply about the community. Here are the items we are collecting:

- Baby Items: diapers (sizes 3-6) & wipes
- Sanitary items: hand sanitizer & toilet paper
- Cleaning Supplies small quantities please
- Snacks similar to what we would provide for Briscoe Buddies
