## *Look Of Missions This Year for FBCSA*

*How do you respond to the call of missions when no mission trips can be made? Are we absolved from our responsibility to take the Gospel to the nations?*



These are questions our Missions Committee has had to address in the wake of CoVid 19. The answer is no... even if we cannot put 'boots on the ground', we still have a responsibility to be obedient to God's command to GO.

Missions looks different for FBCSA this year! With nearly all of the planned trips cancelled for the year, your Missions Committee has been in communication with team leaders, missionaries and partners around the world. Already, we have been able to provide financial support for hunger relief and ministry support in Turkey, Thailand, Dominican Republic, Jemez New Mexico, Burma and the Congo. We have provided support for a new church plant in Brooklyn New York and we have pending requests for Peru and Ukraine. Our partners in all of these areas of the world have been

facing overwhelming needs with their people and have expressed much gratitude for the provisions.

Our missions' dollars are made possible through your faithful giving through our ministry budget. A percentage of each dollar given to First Baptist goes to our Church Missions Initiative (CMI) and is then dispersed around the world through the diligent work of our Missions Committee. Thank you for your support and thank you for praying for our missions' impact around the world. Pray that our decisions will be guided by the Holy Spirit as we seek to spread the Gospel.

In the Dominican Republic, our partners...South Texas Children's Home and IBQ Church in Santo Domingo...are providing food to over 300 families. One family wrote,

"I want to thank God first and then yourselves for the opportune blessing. It came just in time. That day we didn't have any rice left, and my daughter Raquel had given us beans. She said, 'well, as long as we have beans, we'll eat.' She always reminds us that God will supply. Through all these, we've become closer, and I have seen a change in my husband Daniel and in my son Daniel. We've been praying as a family because they've asked if we could all pray together. "All things work together for good.""

In Thailand, 150 families are being fed each week by some of our IMB missionaries. When they received notification of our support, they were out of funds to continue. God is faithful and we have the opportunity to be a small part of His mighty work!
