THIS SUNDAY FBCSA WILL BEGIN "PHASE 3" OF OUR "REOPENING PLAN":

The 8:00 AM Early Service in the Sanctuary will resume. The 11 AM Traditional, LOGOS, & Spanish Services will continue (*Masks are required entering building & to and from worship venues.*) First Kids Dept. will re-open with childcare at 11 AM for babies to 3 yrs. old. Limited to 25% capacity of childcare space. Registration required at fbcsa.org/firstkids. Bible study leaders have been encouraged to teach their classes virtually from classrooms at the church (Teachers Only). This will be phased in building by building each week (Webb, Kokernot, West, etc.). Leaders will be contacted by an Education Staff the week before starting, to get you ready and prepared. As we continue to worship in person at 515 McCullough on Sundays at 8:00 AM & 11:00 AM, we wanted to remind those of you who are planning on attending of what to expect:

- If you have symptoms (fever, cough, or shortness of breath), please worship from home
- If you are at-risk, or if you are not yet comfortable getting out in a crowd, please worship from home
- We are recommending that masks be worn when social distancing of 6ft can not be maintained
- We will practice and encourage Spatial Distancing (seating and hallways)
- Sunday Morning Bible Study Groups will not meet at FBCSA campus yet; Zoom only.
- Traditional and International worship attenders are encouraged to park in the Yellow and Red Lots (formerly Broadway and McCullough Lots)
- LOGOS attenders are encouraged to park in the Tobin Garage or Yellow Lot (formerly Broadway Lot)
- Spanish worship attenders are encouraged to park in the Blue Lot (formerly River Lot)
- Childcare will not be provided
- Greeters will be present to guide you
- Bibles, Hymnals, Paper, and Pencils will be removed
- Printed worship packets will be handed out
- There will be collection boxes located at the exits
- The worship spaces will be cleaned and disinfected before and after every service.
- Railings, restrooms, and hallways will be cleaned frequently
- Doors will be propped open before and after services
- Singing will be limited
