The FBCSA family is united by a unique design for Bible study. We call it *Re:*Verse. The name implies doing something, then backing up and doing it again. *Re:*Verse is an encounter with a designated scripture 5 different ways in a week's time.

READ DAILY: alone with the *Re:*Verse scripture for reflection and prayer **PASTOR'S BLOG:** (TheEverydayPrayer.com): reading a daily contemplation prompted by the scriptures

BIBLE STUDY: meeting in groups around the scriptures for discussion and mutual support

WORSHIP: assembling with the larger church to hear the scripture preached and sung.

CIRCLES OF SIX: gathering with a small group of friends around the scriptures with a focus on application and obedient action.
